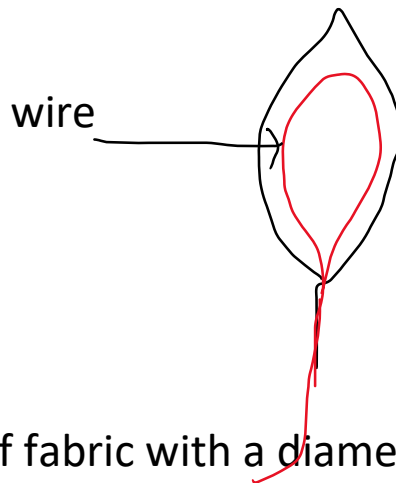


## 60<sup>th</sup> Birthday Celebration Candle Instructions

Some basic instructions to get you on your way

1. Work out how much fabric you need by measuring round the cylinder and the length of the cylinder. This will be the size of the embroidery.
2. Add 1.5 cm for seams. This will be the size of the fabric.
3. When the embroidery is complete, wrap it round the cylinder and ladder stitch the seam together. If the fabric seems a little loose, put some interfacing or lightweight padding between the fabric and the cylinder.
4. Tuck the edges over the cylinder and fasten down (double sided sticky tape is good).
5. Make a 'toilet roll' sized candle flame out of leather, glittery fabric, or even gold paper. Two shapes like this with a piece of wire in between:



6. Cut a circle of fabric with a diameter about a centimetre bigger than the top of the cylinder. Stick the end of the 'flame wire' through the middle of the circle and fasten the wire to the fabric
7. Pin it to the top of the fabric that is already in position and then ladder stitch the circle into place.
